Triple Crown Twin Quinella Rules

- 1. William Hill will offer a special Triple Crown Twin Quinella on selected days starting on Saturday, May 4, 2019.
- 2. The Triple Crown Twin Quinella will consist of two different races per day selected by William Hill management. These races will not necessarily be the Kentucky Derby, Preakness or Belmont Stakes.
- William Hill will guarantee an initial Triple Crown Twin Quinella progressive jackpot pool of \$5,000.
- 4. If there are no winning Triple Crown Twin Quinella tickets purchased on Saturday, May 4 (Kentucky Derby Day), the Triple Crown Twin Quinella jackpot will carry over to Saturday, May 18 (Preakness Stakes Day).
- 5. If there are no winning Triple Crown Twin Quinella tickets purchased on May 18, the Triple Crown Twin Quinella jackpot will carry over to Saturday, June 8 (Belmont Stakes Day).
- 6. If there are no winning Triple Crown Twin Quinella tickets purchased on June 8, the Triple Crown Twin Quinella jackpot will carry over to Saturday, June 15. If no winning tickets are purchased on June 15, the Triple Crown Twin Quinella will carry over to the following Saturday and continue in that pattern until a winning ticket(s) is purchased.
- 7. All William Hill Race Book House Rules and daily Twin Quinella Wagering Rules will apply to the Triple Crown Twin Quinella, except to the extent inconsistent with the foregoing, in which case the foregoing shall prevail.
- 8. The Triple Crown Twin Quinella wager will be available at the William Hill Full-Service Race Books at the Plaza, Silver Sevens, Primm Valley Resort, The Strat, Jerry's Nugget, M Resort, Edgewater, Arizona Charlie's Decatur, Lakeside Inn, Aquarius, Riverside, Avi, Pahrump Nugget, MontBleu Resort, Silver Legacy, Grand Sierra Resort or Circus Circus Reno.
- 9. William Hill management reserves all rights.

Twin Quinella House Rules

- 1. The Twin Quinella, or Twin Q, comprises two different races selected by management. Players must pick the winning Quinella (first two finishers) in both designated races.
- 2. The cost per combination is \$2. Multiple combination tickets will be accepted.
- Management will provide an initial minimum carryover pool. A percentage of each day's Twin Q handle will be added to the next Twin Q pool in the event that it is not hit that day.
- 4. The carryover pool is aggregate. If there are multiple winning tickets, the carryover pool will be divided equally.
- 5. In the event of a late scratch in the first leg of the Twin Q, wagers with the scratched horse will be refunded. For a late scratch in the second leg, only those wagers with the scratched horse and winning combinations in the first leg will be refunded. If a multiple combination ticket has a scratch, the combination involving the scratched horse will be refunded after the second leg of the Twin Q and live combinations will remain as "action."
- Both designated Twin Q races must run with a minimum of eight separate wagering interests. If late scratches reduce a race to fewer than eight separate wagering interests, the Twin Q for that day becomes void and all money wagered will be refunded.
- 7. The Twin Q may be offered at all participating William Hill Race and Sports Books.
- 8. In the event of no winning tickets, the carryover pool will move to the next designated day.
